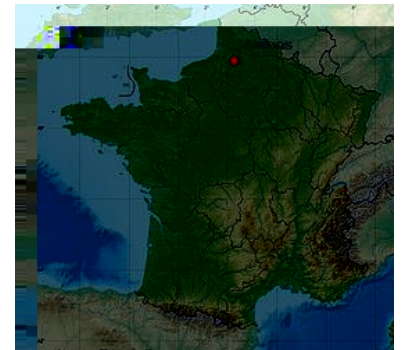

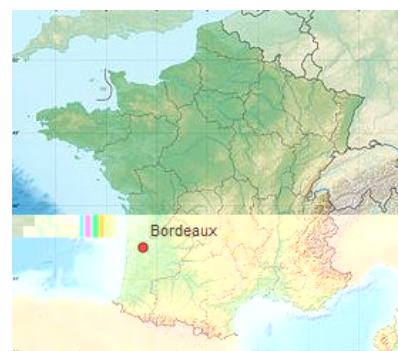

About Grenoble:

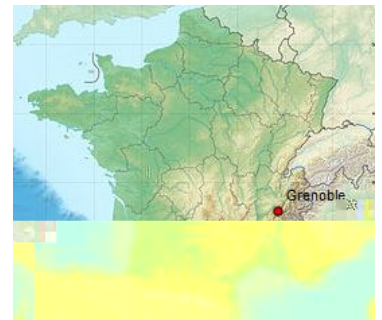
IDRAC Grenoble is located in the ground of the universities' campus of Grenoble.

The city offers all the aspect of a big metropolitan city with a really convenient location, close to everything.

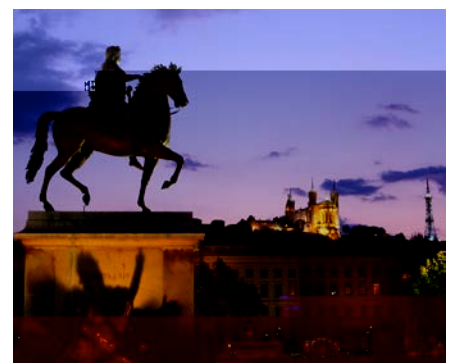
Capital of the gastronomy in France, Lyon is one of the most beloved city in France.

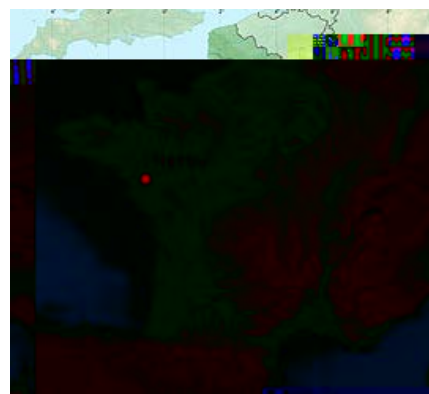

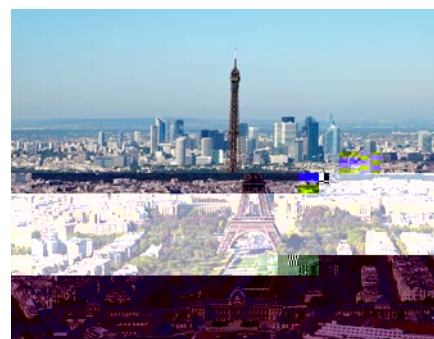
About Paris:

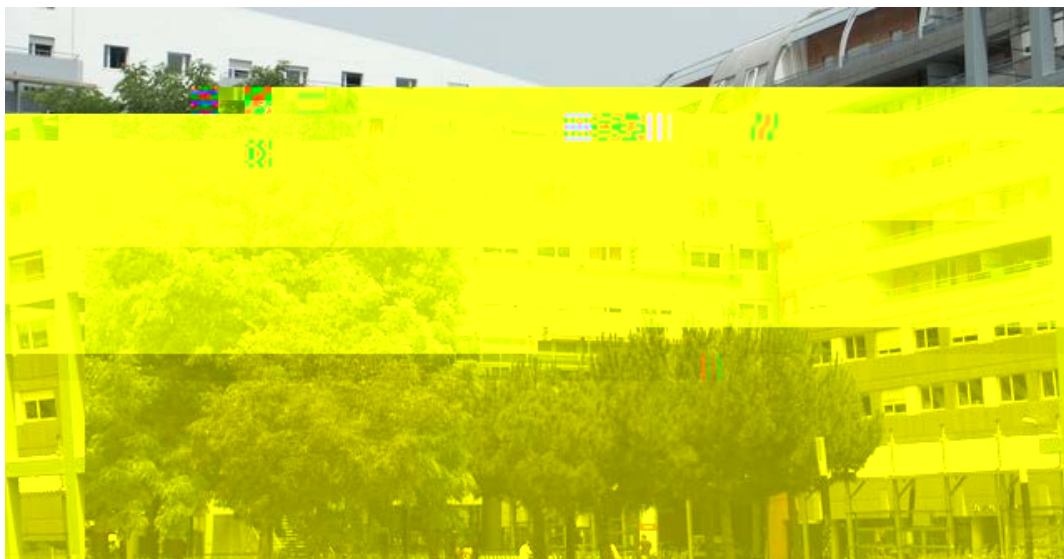
